



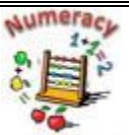

 ENGLISH LANGUAGE	
Reading	In Literacy P1 will continue to build on phonic work, developing and blending sounds to read words with growing confidence .P1 reading books will be issued and returned weekly. Weekly tricky words in class will continue alongside spelling activities. P2 will also be developing their reading through Accelerated Reader and class reading, including comprehension activities.
Writing	P1 will learn about structuring sentences and make their own simple recount texts using words, actions, pictures. Letter formation and handwriting will also be a focus this term.P2 will be developing their reading and writing fluency through report and recount writing. They will consider how to structure and plan writing, asking questions and discussing layout. In comprehension work, P2 will gather information from a text and develop skills to form a clear and accurate answers in writing.
Listening & talking	We will continue to develop core listening skills through following instructions. We will practice social cues i.e. listening to others and sharing respectful opinions. We will discuss the difference between fact and opinion. We will be investigating asking questions and how to form verbal answers.
How can parents help	❖ Read your child a bedtime story- discuss characters, setting and plot. ❖ Look for Reports- news and weather. Talk about facts. Facts are real information. ❖ Spot sign and labels, which letters can you spot? read together, sound out

 MATHS	
Number and number processes	In numeracy P1 will consolidate our learning with numbers 0-20, addition and subtraction, counting on and back and quick mental recall including number bonds. We will take a look at larger numbers (P2 working in hundreds), ordinal numbers and number families. P2 will work on multiplication and its links to number pattern. We will develop our understanding of tens and ones using tens frames, hands on materials, games and smartboard activities.
Angles Transformation Positional language	Naming and using simple angles. P2 learning about right angles. Using directional and positional language. Describing a journey/instruction using left right and position words.
Shape 2D and 3D	Working on identifying 2D and 3D shape. Naming properties and recognising them in everyday situations
Measurement	Using non-standard and standard measurements. Understanding ideas of height, length width, weight and capacity. Estimating and measuring.
How can parents help	❖ Talk about left right under over beside. Left and Right ❖ Look for items to add and subtract in everyday situations. (4apples and 2 apples in the bowl) ❖ Use Sumdog, Topmarks,Toytheater maths games ❖ Look for shapes can you name them? Are they 2D (flat) or 3D (solid)?
