	ENGLISH LANGUAGE	
	Reading	Literacy and Language. P1 will continue to learn and develop letter sounds and spelling following Jolly Phonics, fun actions and rhymes and other activities. P1 will make first steps towards reading, word building and blending and being story tellers. Story telling picture books (wordless books) will start in P1. P2 continues with daily reading practice, working on comprehension and understanding spelling patterns.
	Writing	We will continue to develop our letter formation and handwriting presentation, thinking about the correct shape and where to start on a letter and of course froggy fingers! (a tripod pencil grip). We will be developing spelling and grammar through activities.i.e. Capitals, alphabet work, introduce tricky words and spelling games. In writing P12 will develop our recount skills (news) and look at writing for other purposes, persuasive and procedural (instructions) Emergent literacy skills continue through games and activities to help our understanding of how language and writing works. This term, word boundaries, syllables and what makes a sentence. P2 grammar nouns, verbs and adjectives.
	Listening & talking	Our Big Talk- news, discussing our weekend events. . We will develop core listening skills through news recount and following instructions. We will practice social cues i.e. listening to others and sharing respectful opinions. Listening to our class stories and developing our question and answer skills.

	MATHS	
	Number and number processes	P1 will learn to recognise and read numerals to 20. Order and sequence numerals to 20. Count out objects to 20. Write numbers to 20. Working on understanding tens and ones , place value Addition within 5 and 10, making addition stories. Using number lines and practical resources to help our calculations. We will then go onto Subtraction (within 10 and 20), Odd/Even and Missing Number Sequences. To know to add the bigger number first when carrying out additions. Know that addition can happen in any order but subtraction cannot. Mental calculations (number bonds to 10, doubling and halving.) P2 will work on larger number skills, addition subtraction. Building their skills to apply number knowledge to word problems. We will learn about chance and probability.
	Estimation and rounding	Be aware of estimating and why it is useful, Estimate quantities up to 20 P2 to know how to round to the nearest number. (10s)
	Patterns and relationships/ expressions and equations	We will learn to continue a repeated pattern in shape, colour and numbers. Find a missing number in a sequence and work out the pattern. P2 will work on using <> = +/- Counting in 2,5,10 and more. Recognising number patterns.
