	ENGLISH LANGUAGE				
	READING	In Literacy and Language, we will develop letter sounds/blends, and build on our vocabulary. Reading assessments will be carried out over the term, along with reading groups, and weekly comprehension tasks to develop reading skills. We will be reading in class daily with our reading groups and completing tasks linked to our books.			
	WRITING	We will develop our letter formation and handwriting presentation, thinking about the correct shape and where to start on a letter. We will continue developing spelling using daily activities and grammar i.e. capitals, sentence structure and tricky words. This term recounts and reports will be the writing focus.			
	LISTENING & TALKING	We will develop core listening skills through following instructions. We will practice social cues i.e. listening to others and sharing respectful opinions. We will be starting a 'Look Who's Talking' award in class. This is to encourage children to give answers in complete sentences rather than 1 word answers.

		We will be starting the term focusing on Place Value. We will be learning to recognise and develop understanding of number values. Looking at numbers 0-1000 and beyond. We will be skip counting forwards and backwards in different amounts such as 2s, 5s, 10s, and 100s. We will work on our number facts/bonds linked to Big Math Learn-its. In topic Maths, we will be learning about 2D and 3D shapes.

Look for sequences/patterns.</i> ❖ <i>Look for 2D and 3D shapes in the environment</i> ❖ <i>Practise counting items (count in patterns 2s 5s 10s 15s 100s etc)</i> ❖ <i>Use Sumdog and Topmarks</i> ❖ <i>What can you do in 1 minute?
