ENGLISH LANGUAGE

READING

Having completed our accelerated reader assessment at the start of term, we have focused on creating reading groups to suit our reading abilities. We will spend time every week in class to read together in our groups - asking each other questions to develop our understanding. We will also have time for free reading the class are welcome to take a book from home or read an accelerated reader book from school.

WRITING

This term we will be focusing on writing personal recounts about events we have taken part in. We will be looking at how to structure a recount and how to add in vocabulary and punctuation to make it more exciting for the reader. We will also begin to look at persuasive writing and use our skills to persuade the reader to see our point of view.

LISTENING & TALKING

As we have moved into Primary 4/5 our main focus for listening and talking will be following class rules and routines. We will focus on taking turns when speaking to show everyone respect.

How can parents help

- ❖ Support your child to read their Accelerated Reader every school night.
- ❖ Read with your child.
- ❖ Ask your child questions about their book and support them to find the answer in the text or pictures.
- ❖ Short, frequent homework sessions using weekly spelling words
- ❖ Work together on talk for writing homework.



MATHS

In Maths this term we will be focusing on place value to give us good starting point for the year ahead. We will then move onto looking at addition and into our wider maths areas discussing measurement. We aim to finish the term looking at data and analysis. We will continue to complete our CLICs, SAFEs and Learn its each week in class.

How can parents help

- ❖ Use Sumdog for 20 minutes a week.
- ❖ Verbal practice of questions from their Learn-its and of times tables they are learning. Estimate time, weight, length, distance in everyday life.



HEALTH AND WELLBEING / INTERDISCIPLINARY LEARNING

The class will have two PE sessions with Mr Kearton a week, one on Tuesday and the other a Thursday - they must remember to bring a PE kit on these days. In class we will be covering other areas of health and wellbeing. Our IDL focus this term is Rights and Responsibilities and we will be focusing on the right to clean water, food and shelter. We will be making close links to food nutrition and food chains. We will also be focusing on creating our class charter making sure we are linking this to our rights.



SKILLS FOR STARS – EARNING AN OSCAR

This term we will be focusing on Collaborating, Feeling and Leading Metaskills. Each week we will have a different Metaskill focus and a member of the class showing this skill and general kindness and school values will get the Oscar. We will be reflecting on our learning at the end of every week using our skills to see our progress.
