 Literacy	ENGLISH LANGUAGE	
	READING	There will be lots of opportunities to share books together and choosing stories to be read. We can make our own stories from pictures and using our imagination.
	WRITING	Some of us in Rainbow Room will have lots of different experiences with mark making. Some of us will be using our writing skills to form our letters correctly and writing short sentences.
	LISTENING & TALKING	Listening and talking is very important during our day in Rainbow Room. We encourage the children to tell us how they are feeling and encourage the children to identify reasons for the way they are feeling. Every day we have story time where the children can choose books to come and read with us. There is lots of discussion about what we are reading and asking the children to predict what might happen next.

	Patterns	There will be opportunities to make patterns using different materials: lego bricks, pom- poms, Duplo, coloured blocks. We will follow instructions on cards and use the pictures to re-create the patterns. Some of us will record our patterns on paper.
	2D & 3D shape	Using shapes we will look at their properties, see which ones can tile and try to learn their names. We will have building opportunities with 3D shapes and look at which shapes might roll or stack and what they are called

How can parents help	<i>Can you spot patterns at home, make patterns using items from home. Look at shapes in the home and say their names. Can you have a shape hunt around the house?</i>
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 	HEALTH AND WELLBEING / INTERDISCIPLINARY LEARNING	
	In Health and wellbeing we will be using Global Goal 3, (good health and wellbeing) through our cooking club. We will look at the healthy plate, what should we be eating and how much of each group to keep our bodies healthy. In Rainbow Room we will also be reminding ourselves how to work alongside each other by setting up our class charter. We will be using The Zones of Regulation to talk about how we are feeling. Once we recognise our feelings we will have a look at strategies we can use to help us IDL this term is learning about our rights. We will be using Elmer the Elephant stories to help us understand differences and friendship. Inviting friends to join our afternoon clubs in Rainbow room and joining classes for activities will help us understand that we have the right to join groups.	

	SKILLS FOR STARS - EARNING AN OSCAR	
	In Rainbow Room we look at Teamwork and Focussing. What does it look like to work as part of a team, encouraging the children to recognise when they are doing this and what they achieved as a team, recording this themselves by using the class iPad to record it. We will be talking about being focussed when working on our tasks and how that helps us achieve. Every day we will recognise someone for 'star of the day', recognising their efforts with our skills focus. Once a month the children's efforts will be recognised by being awarded the Oscar.
