	ENGLISH LANGUAGE	
	READING	This term we will be focussing on developing our reading skills through answering a range of comprehension questions. Pupils work in groups to research their novel studies and gain a better understanding of themes and genres. We will develop our reciprocal reading skills through this as well as continuing to work on fluency and tone. Time to read Accelerated Reader will be given in class. These books can be brought in from home but must be within your ZPD and a book that hasn't been read previously. ZPD levels can be checked at home at Accelerated Reader Bookfinder UK & Ireland - Welcome (arbookfind.co.uk)
	WRITING	Our Big Write will continue to be on a Wednesday. We will start the term focussing on narrative writing, looking at how to create an effective setting description and use this in our writing, we will also look at how to add suspense and mystery to our writing. Following this, we will be working on instructional and procedural writing, using real life experiences to create well structures and detailed writing. Please look at the talk for writing homework grid on teams and discuss this at home prior to our Big Writing.
	LISTENING & TALKING	This term we will continue to take time practicing presenting work that we are proud of. We will be working on our Christmas performance, learning a song as well as some pupils having speaking roles. We will work on tone and volume, as well as being effective communicators.

How can parents help	❖ Support your child to read their Accelerated Reader every school night. Help your child look for a book to read for Accelerated reader. Check the ZPD level on ZPD bookfinder level ❖ Short, frequent homework sessions using weekly spelling words and homework grid. Reinforce spelling words by using them in writing, discuss words that also have the same spelling sound. ❖ Discuss the talk for writing homework every week.
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	MATHS	
		This term we will working on subtraction and calculating missing values. We will continue to complete weekly Big Maths CLICs, SAFEs and LearnIts to re-inforce our knowledge and will be using "learning gap" sheets in class to help support progress. For wider maths we will be focusing on angles, symmetry and transformation and properties of 3D shape, this will follow on from the learning we have completed this term on shape rotation and directions.
