	ENGLISH LANGUAGE			
	READING	We will continue with our Accelerated Readers and will re-do assessments over the term to give the books at the correct level. These books will be read in class and be taken home – children should be bringing these in every day. Weekly comprehension tasks will be completed to develop reading skills and children will continue to read in groups to focus on oral fluency.		
	WRITING	We will develop our letter formation and handwriting presentation, thinking about the correct shape and where to start on a letter. We will continue developing spelling using daily activities. Our focus in writing will be on impersonal recounts and explanation texts.		
	LISTENING & TALKING	We will develop core listening skills through following instructions. We will practice social cues i.e. listening to others and sharing respectful opinions.

	Addition & subtraction; angles, symmetry & transformation; shape	We will be using our knowledge we have developed so far in P4/5 and using this to help us with skip counting and commutative addition/subtraction. Our prior learning will also help us with money as well as fractions, decimals and percentages. Estimation and rounding will also be covered. As always, number facts/bonds linked to Big Math Learn its; times tables facts.		
	Encourage your child to: ❖ Use Sumdog ❖ Verbal practise of questions from their Learn-its and of times tables they are learning. ❖ Look for numbers around them – e.g. on houses, number plate, magazines. ❖ Ask what comes next? more than? less than? Look for sequences/patterns. ❖ When out in shops, look at prices at items and work out what is cheaper/more expensive/best value. What coins and/or notes do you need to pay? What would your change be?
