ENGLISH LANGUAGE: READING, WRITING, LISTENING & TALKING

We will be using our scan and skim skills to research for information and find key evidence within a range of texts. Book novel studies continue with children developing on their comprehension skills and analysis. We will be studying Alone on a Wide, Wide Sea, Adolphus Tips and A series of animal tales this term and looking at the country of Qatar. Accelerated Reader will continue with a daily reading slot and quizzes taking place. Our goal is to get 85% or above in each quiz. We will be learning how to write instructions in our procedural genre focus. We will use our research skills to create a range of presentation pieces of writing which will be shared with other classes within the school. To support the writing of instructions we will be taking part in a range of instruction based tasks to appreciate the use of oral, verbal and visual instructions.

How can parents help

- ❖ Encourage your child to take their accelerated reader book between home and school and read daily. Be a good role model and let your child see you read for enjoyment.



MATHS: Number Processes, Shape, Measurement,

This term we will apply our multiplication and division knowledge to complete a range of mental and written calculations solving sums and word problems. Big maths safes, clics and learn its will provide us an opportunity to revisit and practise these. We will be studying the properties of 2 and 3 dimensional shapes and making links to the angles within shapes. We will link this to symmetry and geometric designing within Art. We will use a range of practical activities for children to find volume, area, perimeter and weight to investigate and experiment with using mathematical equipment and converting units of measure.

How can parents help

Encourage your child to: investigate units of measure in the home environment. Can you find grams, kilograms, metres, litres?
 Can you find 3D shapes at home, how many edges, corners (vertices) and faces to they have?
