	READING	We will continue with our Accelerated Readers and will re-do assessments over the term to give the books at the correct level. These books will be read in class and be taken home – children should be bringing these in every day. Weekly comprehension tasks will be completed to develop reading skills and children will continue to read in groups to focus on oral fluency.			
	WRITING	We will develop our letter formation and handwriting presentation, thinking about the correct shape and where to start on a letter. We will continue developing spelling using daily activities. We will be writing instructions and looking at how we can persuade people with our writing. Our grammar will be linked to this and will focus on imperative (bossy) words and persuasive language.			
	LISTENING & TALKING	We will develop core listening skills through following instructions. We will practice social cues i.e. listening to others and sharing respectful opinions.

	Addition & subtraction; angles, symmetry & transformation; shape	We will be using our knowledge of addition, place value and number from term 1 to help us with subtraction. We will learn formal methods of subtraction as well as developing our knowledge of number bonds. We will look at doubling and halving, along with number sequences and patterns. Number facts/bonds linked to Big Math Learn its. For beyond number, we will be looking at properties of 2D and 3D shapes. We will be looking for angles in the world around us and measuring the angles as well as learning to classify angles.			
	Encourage your child to: ❖ Use Sumdog ❖ Verbal practise of questions from their Learn-its and of times tables they are learning. ❖ Look for numbers around them – e.g. on houses, number plate, magazines. ❖ Ask what comes next? more than? less than? Look for sequences/patterns.
